

Residents' Association Committee meeting – July 2011

A Meeting of the Committee took place on Tuesday, 12th July 2011. In addition to Committee members, Councillor Joan Spiers was in attendance.

In addition to formal matters:

Councillor Spiers reported on:

- Several local Planning Applications.
- The Royal Horticultural Society's introduction of their 'Growing Communities' scheme and indicated that further information was available via the RHS website.
- The Localism Bill and indicated that, whilst it would apply in the main to cities, any impact on the Borough would involve consultation with relevant Residents' Associations.
- The Banstead Leisure Centre redevelopment and stated that the swimming pool would be retained. The redevelopment would involve the re-location of the Centre to a new site with the existing site being sold and developed for affordable housing.
- The 'Fox on the Hill' and indicated that it would remain a restaurant, but with more bar space and general refurbishment.
