

Residents' Association Committee meeting – July 2016

A Meeting of the Committee took place on Tuesday, 12th July 2016. In addition to Committee members, Councillors Bob Gardner, Joan Spiers & Ros Mill were in attendance.

Councillor Mill reported on:

- The current situation regarding the use of the Recreation Ground by football teams.
- Following a discussion regarding the present state of the Pavilion, Cllr. Mill agreed to look into the situation.

Councillor Spiers stated that:

- She was delighted to be able once again to attend Committee meeting now that her Mayoral duties had come to an end; she also gave her endorsement to her successor as Mayor.

Councillor Gardner reported on:

- The use of discrete CCTV equipment to monitor various recycling facilities across the County.
- A survey that he was undertaking of the roads and footpaths in the village with a view to organising remedial work where necessary.
- Irresponsible vehicle parking, which was still a problem causing damage to verges and footpaths. Following a discussion regarding the parking of large commercial vehicles close to specific road junctions, resulting in potential traffic hazards and inconvenience, Cllr. Gardner suggested a number of possible solutions, which might serve to alleviate the situation.
